

# LICENSING PROCESS FLOWCHART

DMV Learner's  
Permit (LP)

- Student must be 15 and 6 months before taking the DMV permit test.

- Student should begin logging supervised driving time with a parent.

Classroom  
Driver's  
Education

- Includes classroom, instruction, simulation, and in-car driving range.
- Student continues logging supervised driving time with a parent.

DEC-1  
(Green card)

- Completed by the Driver Education Classroom Teacher, and kept on file at home school.
- Summer Academy cards are sent to home school at course end.

Behind the  
Wheel (BTW)

- \$100 payable to school; submit to Driver Education Classroom Teacher.
- 3 days, 6 hours total, before or after school; assigned by Classroom Teacher.

Temporary  
Driver's License  
(TDL-180)

- Completed log must have 45 hours.
- At least 16 years and 3 months of age.
- Must hold LP for at least 9 months.
- Picked up at Main Office by parent and student on or after eligibility date.

Permanent  
Driver's License

- TDL is valid for 6 months.
- Student and parent must attend court-appointed licensing ceremony.
